July 1, 2017 - June 30, 2021 Waste Management Contract

A note from Andy Reynolds, Waste Management Louisville's Public Sector Representative and fellow Strathmoor Manorite...

On Saturday, July 1st, residents of the City of Strathmoor Manor will be receiving a new, larger recycling container. The new container will be identical to the trash container provided by Waste Management, except it will have a yellow lid and be marked "RECYCLING ONLY." You may keep your current recycle bin, but if you would like to return it, please place it at the curb on the morning of Saturday, July 1st.

Due to the increased size of the container, recycling will no longer be collected every week. There will be no collection the first week of July, and every-other-week collecting will begin Tuesday, July 11th.

Trash and yard waste will continue to be collected weekly. In accordance with city regulations, yard waste cannot be placed in plastic bags, and any loose limbs must be bundled and no longer than three feet in length.

We have also received questions on disposing of large items. As part of the contract with Waste Management, one large item may be placed at the curb for disposal each week. **However, mattresses and box springs will not be collected unless they are wrapped in plastic, due to the possibility of bed bug contamination.** Wraps can be purchased from The Home Depot or Lowe's for around \$7.00.

News from the Forestry Board!

In June, the roundabout at Eleanor Ave. received new landscaping, which includes a combination of hydrangeas (16), drift roses (12), boxwoods (19), junipers (13), and lirope (54).

The plan was provided by a local landscaper and should improve aesthetically as the plants grow. Installation was competitively bid, and Greenway Landscape Services completed the work. Plant purchases were also independently bid to reduce cost. Eason Horticultural Resources, a nursery broker in Northern Kentucky, provided the materials. Thanks to Emily and Bruce Felhoelter for allowing the city to use their spigot to water the plants over their first summer!

Other updates related to the Forestry Board are twofold: first, removal/leveling of the park landscaping mounds, which will occur in late June/early July to be followed with additional trees and plantings in the fall. These will need to be watered by neighbor volunteers. secondly, the Forestry Board is engaging an independent arborist, Cindi Sullivan, to make recommendations about tree planting and maintenance of trees in the public spaces and rights-of-way in front of each house, as well as assist with coordinating/bidding the work annually. **Once removed/leveled, the mounds will need to be watered by neighbor**





- Salad dressing bottles
- Milk/water jugs
- Laundry/cleaning products containers

DO NOT RECYCLE:

- Plastic bags
- Plastic containers used for motor oil, automotive products, paint, solvents, lawn care products, and chemicals

GLASS (ALL COLORS)



- Juice, pop & soda bottles
- Water bottles
- Beer & wine bottles
- Food jars

DO NOT RECYCLE:

- Drinking glasses, dishes
- Mirrors or window glass
- Light bulbs
- Broken glass

METAL



- Tin food cans
- Aluminum & Steel beverage cans
- Aluminum foil and pie pans
- Aerosol spray cans

DO NOT RECYCLE

- Cans used for chemicals or paints
- Appliances, power tools
- Batteries
- Hangers

NEWSPAPER CARDBOARD



- All newspapers
- Drink boxes, milk & juice cartons
- Food boxes, cereal, etc.) – Remove liners in boxes
- Junk mail or other papers
- Magazines

DO NOT RECYCLE

- Books
- Beverage cartons (soft drink & beer cases)
- Phone Books
