Minutes for May 22, 2018**

The Meeting Minutes for April, 2018 were approved.

**Police Business** - No reports were available.

**Resident Business** - None

**Financial Report** -

The monthly financial information for April was not available.

Materials for the FY 2015/16 final statement to DLG and audit are being prepared.

It was agreed that money needs to be moved to the Road Fund during June.

**General City** -

Google Fiber has placed the small, satellite cities on hold until probably winter.

Strathmoor Village will charge the Manor \$28,000 a year for police services and a new contract will be sent that is same as the current one.

**City Business/Legal** –

Registration of the rental properties will be done shortly.

First reading of the budget ordinance for FY 2018 -19 in Series 2018, Number 3 was done at the last meeting, it must be passed at the June meeting.

**Maintenance Report** -

The park installation has been completed and watering of the new plants is needed. Korphage's bid of \$400 per time was received and rejected. Contacts with neighbors to water one area of the park plantings for a stipend of \$150 for the season is being implemented.

Nally has mulched trees and weeded both public areas. Nally wants to a monthly payment, rather than invoice based payment. There was consensus that a written agreement needs to be submitted by Nally with a July 1st start date for the Commission to review.

The arborist agreed that the 2 pines on Shelley near the Boyd's house need to be removed. Also, it was agreed that those trees do not need to be replaced.
