The Minutes for the April 23, 2019 meeting were approved.

Police Business - The police report for April was reviewed. Mike Lamey will be the new Strathmoor Police Chief beginning June 1st.

Resident Business -

A resident has inquired about buying the adjoining house and combining the two houses into one. This would require multiple permits from Metro including Planning and Zoning and Strathmoor Manor.

Financial-

The monthly financial information for April, 2019 was reviewed.

The audit proposals will be reviewed at the June meeting.

The tax bills have been mailed.

General City -

It was noted that personal items, such as a soccer net, may be used in the park, but not left there overnight. A notice will be put on the FB page.

City Business/Legal –
