General City -

Councilman Brandon Coen was contacted about a halfway house in Metro Louisville on Emerson across from Atherton. It was noted that the Manor has no authority over planning and zoning.

A discussion was held about the Park and residents permanently leaving personal items in the Park and removing and changing plants. It was noted that this is public property and is not to be used as a private yard. Those residents who wish to help with the plantings or weeding should contact Zandona. This will be explained in a future newsletter and on the private Manor Facebook page.

The Manor will follow the guidance of Metro and the Governor regarding Trick or Treating.

City Business/Legal - Harrison explained the challenges of detailing the bid specifications for sidewalk repair, ADA compliance and curb cuts. Following a lengthy discussion, he will submit specs at the next meeting.
