Minutes for December 7, 2021**

In attendance: Commissioners: Brian Cobb, Brooke Heitz, Susan Stopher, Kathy Zandona and Bob Peterson; John Harrison, Attorney; and Police Chief, Mike Lamey.

The Resolution Series 2021, Number 11 authorizing the Strathmoor Manor Commission to meet in a “zoom” format in accordance with the state of emergency in regard to Covid-19 epidemic was unanimously passed.

The Minutes for the October, 2021 meeting were approved.

Police Business-

Lamey outlined the October and November, 2021 police reports. He also reported that he will do a Security Survey for any resident.

Financial-

Financial reports for October and November, 2021 were previously distributed and approved.

All property taxes have been paid.

It was determined to renew the CD at the end of the month.

Cobb will check on the status of our audit.

Cobb filed the form declining the American Rescue Plan monies due the lack of clarity as to allowed expenses.

General City -

Cobb reported on the continuing efforts to complete the KY Department of Transportation grant for monies for the sidewalk project.

City Business/Legal -

Harrison reported that the police contract with Strathmoor Village has been signed, submitted to DLG, and is still awaiting their legal review.

Maintenance Report -

Zandona reported on the extensive tree removal and trimming completed Zang.

Fall tree planting did not happen, but will in February.

Zandona will discuss with Nalley about power seeding the park when weather permits possible, painting the stop signs and treating for weeds in the spring.
