The Minutes for the August, 2022 meeting were approved.

Police Business-

The August, 2022 police report was reviewed.

Financial-

Financial reports for August, 2022 were reviewed.

Only one resident still owes the property tax for this year.

Cobb will complete the year end report for June 30, 2022 and submit it to the KY Department of Local Government (DLG) with copies to the commissioners.

Resident Business -

Melissa Reynolds, 2150 Emerson, sought guidance on replacing their driveway and the right of way between the sidewalk and street and any necessary Strathmoor Manor approvals and permissions. It was agreed that a the right of way could be be repaved, a dumpster used and that the sidewalk must be in the same condition after the work as prior to its start.

A resident has complained about the maintenance of land between Emerson and Strathmoor along Bardstown Road. After a length discussion, it was agreed that a call to Metro be done.

General City -

The KY Department of Transportation TAP grant was not awarded to Strathmoor Manor. The sidewalk bid will be again be issued for work in the Spring.

Discussion was held about Waste Management's reduced services. Waste Management has adjusted the most recent bill to reflect this.

City Business/Legal -

Harrison had no issue to report.

Maintenance Report -

Some fall tree planting will be done this fall.
