Police Business-

Financial-

Financial report for January, 2023 was reviewed.

Cobb completed and submitted the UFIR to the Department of Local Government (DLG) for the year ending June 30, 2022.

General City -

The sidewalk bids were opened. Bids were received from the following: Flynn Brothers at \$178,844.60; TRC, LLC at \$244,000 and Hall Contracting of KY, Inc at \$148,000. A special call meeting will be held Tuesday, March 7 at 6:00 pm in the park to select a contractor.

There was discussion about Waste Management. This will be reviewed again next month.

City Business/Legal - None

Maintenance Report -

Zandona reported that two trees have been planted and a tulip poplar should be planted

soon.

Nalley's has proposed a 3 year lawn care and ice removal contract. The Manor can't enter a contract of that amount without bidding the work. It was agreed to again enter a one year contract for lawn care, but not include snow services. The contract will be for one year at \$19,000 for a monthly fee of \$1,583.33. Zandona will also discuss with him the weeds in circle and grass in park.
