The Commission unanimously moved to keep this year's property tax rate at \$0.30 per \$100 of valuation. Tax bills are being mailed to homeowners or mortgage companies. *Property taxes are due and payable on August 31st. Ordinance Series 2023, Number 1

AN ORDINANCE relating to the ad valorem tax rate on real property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STRATHMOOR MANOR that:

Section 1. Section 2.605(a) of the Strathmoor Manor Code of Ordinances shall continue to read as follows:

The tax rate on non-exempt real property within the corporate limits of the City of Strathmoor Manor shall be 30,00 cents per \$1,00,00 valuation.

Section 2. Section 2.605(b) of the Strathmoor Manor Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

This ordinance shall take effect with the issuance of the 2022-2023 Property Tax Bills of the City based on valuations of real property as of January 1st, 2022-2023 by the Jefferson County Property Valuation Administrator.
